



Commitment to Learning Policy

When students accept their conditional offer they automatically agree to the commitment to learning policy which is in place to support their learning in sixth form.

As a sixth form, we expect students to want to be here; learning everyday. All sixth form students are required to be in school 100% of the time and engage with their lessons – being committed to their learning.

We expect students to:

- Be on time to lessons
- Be ready to learn every lesson – bring the correct equipment and resources
- Engage with tasks which are set
- Complete home learning by the deadline (7 days)
- Communicate with staff if there are issues with completing work by deadlines and of a standard
- Complete all requirements of the course as expected by the subject teacher and faculty leader
- Attend all studies on their timetable and independently work throughout that time
- Attend all mock examinations as required
- Avoid booking appointments during lesson time
- Attend all tutor sessions and assemblies

By accepting your place in sixth form you automatically agree to these expectations. You also understand that if you are not meeting the expectations of the policy you are at risk of having your home studies removed, attending a parent meeting or being placed on an action plan.
