

Study Expectations

All students have 1 allocated study per subject **per week** on their timetable. This is a timetabled session and all students must attend and is part of their full-time offer here at NOA Sixth Form. Study sessions are important in developing student's independence to learning but also allow us to support should they need any guidance.

Students are expected to:

- Work independently on the computers or at tables in the designated study area
- Maintain a working environment by keeping noise to a minimum
- Complete work to the best of their ability within the designated time
- Remove themselves from distractions and focus on their work

Students will receive support from the study supervisor and the sixth form team through:

- One to one intervention on exam skills and revision
- Adjustments made to their timetable to accommodate extra support (extra studies added, for example)
- Action planning with the Head of Sixth Form to improve outcomes in subject areas which may result in removal of home studies
- Discussions about progress with the study supervisor or the sixth form leaders
- Access to Chromebooks and computers, JSTOR online library and online revision tools (Seneca, Uplearn etc.)

Home studies:

- Students are welcome to stay on site for their home study periods, but they must be adhering to the study expectations above
- If students decide to stay on site, they will need to sit in the home study area, which is signposted
- Students will be asked to leave the study area if they are distracting the learning environment
- We may remove these from students timetables if we feel they are behind with work, have truanted a study period or are failing to meet basic expectations in their subject areas
