Apprenticeship Fair – over 33 exhibitors

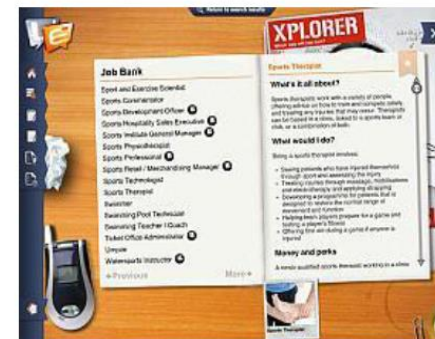
