

NORTH OXFORDSHIRE ACADEM STUDENTS CELEBRATE A LEVEL SUCCESS



Sixth Form students at North Oxfordshire Academy have been celebrating receiving their A Level results, which saw strong improvements on all key headline measures.

For the academy's Year 13 cohort:

- The percentage of entries achieving the top grades of A* or A doubled to 17%;
- 45% of entries were graded A*-B, up from 35% last year;
- 71% of entries achieved A*-C, also an increase on 2016's results;
- There was a 99% pass rate overall.
