I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for the last few days of the year 11 GCSE exam session.

Study Leave and post-exams arrangements

Students have been expected in school as usual throughout the exam period, but from the end of the Science / chemistry exam which finishes at 10.45am on **Wednesday 12th June**, students will be allowed home on study leave. They will only be expected to attend school after this date for scheduled examinations and for timetabled revision/final preparation sessions for specific subjects, as outlined in their exam and revision timetable. All students have copies of their individual exam schedules.

May I remind you that students officially remain on the school role until the Friday 28th June and therefore the expectation is that until then, if they are on home study, they are supervised and not in the community during school hours. If you have any anxieties around this, please contact the school.

Leavers' Assembly

On **Friday 14th June**, we look forward to welcoming our Year 11 students back into school for their formal Leavers' Assembly. This will take place after lunch, in the main hall and students are welcome to arrive from 1.30pm. Access to the hall will be through the external doors. **Students must wear full school uniform for the assembly**; those who arrive without this will not be allowed to attend and will be sent home. This is the last opportunity year 11s will have to be together as a year group so please encourage your son or daughter to attend.

Sixth Form Induction Day

For those students who have applied to NOA Sixth form, there will be an induction day on Wednesday 3rd July. This day is compulsory for prospective sixth form students and will give them an insight into what to expect when they return to the academy in September as sixth formers. Please contact the school if there are any issues with your child's attendance at this event as non-attendees will have their sixth form offers withdrawn.
