> Still Image - This is a static picture that is used to represent people, objects, situations but also abstract concepts like emotions or atmospheres

Slow Motion - To move your body at a slow rate and maintain this slow pace for a period of time.

Choral Speaking - A group of actors narrating a poem or dramatic piece. This is often using various voice combinations and contrasts to bring out the meaning.



System of Movement - Each member of the group has a series of actions conveying a character or location. Each action is held for four seconds before the actor moves to another position on the stage. This is usually done in silence



Exposition - Is performed in role as the character and is designed to give important information to the audience quickly. Usually a character's name, age and information on the plot, other characters, past events or a back
