



Youth Voice Champions Project

We have an exciting opportunity from Oxfordshire Youth, we are currently recruiting 6 Youth Voice Champions (ages 14–18) to help lead change, advocate for young people's rights, and ensure youth voices are heard at all levels.

This is a co-produced programme where young people will:

- Gain new skills
- Boost their CVs
- Achieve AQA qualifications
- Have their expenses covered
- Be empowered to lead meaningful youth-driven initiatives

Sessions will run every Monday, 6–8pm from June to November 2025, and no previous experience is required. Sessions will run in Oxford but transport will be provided for young people.
