You are now going to turn this into a transcription using **simplified Jeffersonian style**.

(.) – indicates a micropause, a pause of under one second

(1) – indicates a pause, the number is how many seconds

word – indicates emphasis, putting stress on the word

WORD – indicates higher volume

WO:::RD – Indicates elongating the vowel sound, making the word last longer

[word] – Indicates contextual notes added by you, such as sounds that are not speech, actions, or inaudible utterances

You must read through your typed data whilst watching and listening to the original source data, turning your writing into a transcription.
