

Collecting Your GCSE Results

Dear Student,

This letter outlines the process for collecting your GCSE examination results this year. Results will be available for collection on Thursday 25th August 2022 between 9.00am and 10.30am from the main J block hall. Collection times have been staggered to give students a better opportunity to discuss any issues with staff present on the day. Please, where possible, aim to collect your results in your collection time window as laid out in the table below in alphabetical surname order.

Entry to the hall will be through the external doors. Please feel free to come with a family member if you wish. If a member of your family is collecting results on your behalf, you will need to have given written consent to the school via Mandy Allen, the exams officer, prior to results day. The nominated person collecting will also need to bring photo ID. If you cannot collect your results on the day and have not made alternative arrangements with us, results will be available for collection from reception during its opening hours of 9.00 – 4.00pm weekdays.

There will be an opportunity for those of you who have applied for NOA sixth form and have met your offer conditions to confirm your place on the day, and members of the sixth form team will be available to advise on changes to any programmes where required. As always, school staff, including our careers team, will also be available to discuss your results and support those of you who have applied elsewhere.
